It will be seen that although there are indications of improvement, the figures are small. The exports in 1911 are affected by entries for pickled fish, \$56,822, pig lead, \$74,840, and laths, \$10,600, which do not appear in subsequent years. The percentage of increase in 1913 is satisfactory, being slightly over 100 per cent above the average for 1911, 1912. The principal item is that of fish, \$357,993, and the next in importance is wheat, \$205,711. In this case the upward tendency is very marked.
