

By-Laws.

NAME AND OBJECTS.

1. The name of this Society shall be "First British Columbia Society of Spiritualists."
2. The objects are as follows:—
 - a. The support of public lectures, private and public meetings, seances, and the building of a hall and lecture room.
 - b. The establishment, support and maintenance of a library, lyceums and such other scientific undertakings as may be deemed best by the Society for the furtherance and investigation of the claims of Spiritualism.
 - c. To stimulate the mind to the freest thought on all subjects, especially the spiritual philosophy and cognate matters; to quicken philanthropic impulses; stimulating enlightening and unselfish labors for human good, under the assurance that the redeemed and exalted spirits of the human race are encompassing them as a cloud of witnesses, inspiring to the work and aiding forward to a certain and glorious time.
