Judge Mackay said he could not support the amendment as worded. He declined to thank Mr. Molson. He deserved no thanks, having regard to the terms of the proposal.

The amendment was seconded by the Rev. Mr. Wells, put to the meeting and lost. The vote stood 22 for and 26 against, Judge Mackay not voting. A governor has five votes, a life member two, and an annual member one.

The original motion was then put and also lost, the number being, for, 25; against, 27.

After a few words from Canon Norman, on the retirement of Mr. Matthews from the Council, of which body he has been a member for the last twenty-five years, and in which position he has ever shown himself energetic and helpful in furthering the cause of Art and Art Education.

The customary vote of thanks to the Chairman and Scrutineers having been passed, the meeting was adjourned sine die.
