

turned to England. In reference to what he and his party have accomplished lately Captain Parker says: "Our quest was based on a cypher discovered by a Swede which purported to show the exact position on Mount Orphel (or Mount Moriah) where lay buried old treasures of Israel, including vessels of ritual, ancient manuscripts, etc. At this moment it is not possible to say how far the cypher is correct. We have found beyond all doubt that the ancient city of David was not on Mount Zion, as is usually accepted, but on Mount Orphel. Much of the pottery found dates back as far as 3000 B.C., and is unique."
