ORDERED, that Mr. Auldjo have leave to bring in a Bill for appointing Commissioners to treat with Commissioners appointed, or to be appointed by the Province of Upper Canada.

Accordingly he presented the said Bill to the House, and the same was received and read for the first time.

ORDERED, that the faid Bill be read a fecond time on Saturday next.

The Order of the Day being read, for taking into consideration a motion made by Mr. Young on Tuesday the 18th instant: The said motion is as follows, "That it be an instruction to the Committee (appointed to prepare and bring in a Bill for the nomination of returning Officers, &c.) To consider and report what qualifications are necesfary to entitle persons to be elected Members of this House"—was read, and the House accordingly proceeded to take the same into consideration.

Mr. Grant moved, seconded by Mr. Bonav. Panet, that the consideration of the same should be postponed to the first of August next.

The House divided upon the question, and the Names were taken down as follow:
