SELF-CONSTITUTED COMMITTEE.

The Rossland Bureau of Information, organized by public-spirited citizens of the camp with a view to the dissemination of information respecting Trail Creek and its mines, has begun active work by sending energetic representatives to interview the press and to obtain money for the purpose of carrying on this great work.

THE SEASON'S WORK AND ITS RESULTS: London & B. C. Goldfields.—A. Nelson, B. C. Dec. 4.—Special.—A. W. Whittenden, of the Ontario Crawford Creek, one of the owners of the Monte Carlo and California, was in town last Thursday. He says that they will probably sell or stock the claims before next spring. Work on the Silver Spring, a 100 foot tunnel has been run in the California a 25 foot tunnel has been run. The smelter returns of these two mines are as follows: per cent silver, 20; per cent lead and zinc, 60; per cent copper, five tons are now at the Kaslo smelting works. The ore is a clear gray copper.

The Long property, belonging to Messrs Robbald, Matthews and Lareu, at the head of Crawford Creek, which shows a tonnage of five or six tons of lead and a seven foot ledge of solid galena and the quartz showing can be traced the entire length of the claim. A tunnel of 80 feet has now been run but work has now closed down for the winter. Assays show 116 ounces in silver, 2 ounces in gold, 26 per cent lead, and 4 to 5 per cent in copper.
