Lumber Dealers Must Obtain Sales Tax License

Manufacturers of lumber and wholesale or retail lumber dealers hereafter must obtain a sales tax license and make a monthly return of sales of lumber to nonlicensees according to an order ssued by the Department of Customs. The order says that The tax shall be computed on not less than fifty percent of their selling price to such purchaser' at the rate of six percent.

Retail lumber dealers who do not manufacture lumber to other. dealers or manufacturers need not take out a sales tax license.




