

Under the provisions of the War Measures Act, His Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to order that the Regulations of date April 11th, 1918, made in consequence of the Military Service Act, whereby all persons were forbidden to leave Newfoundland without Passports, shall be cancelled from this date.

In other respects the Passport Regulations are as heretofore, and Passports will still be required of persons entering all Countries, except the Dominion of Canada.
