**MAUDE ADAMS AS PETER PAN HAS ALL SECRETS OF ETERNAL YOUTH**

Great Calgary Audience Fairly Revels With the Boy Who Would Never Grow Up

Who are you, Pan? I'm Youth Eternal Youth. I'm the sun shining in the sky. I'm the new world; I'm a little bird That has broken out of the egg. I'm joy, joy, joy.

It is an individual in this fair city who does not see in fairyland a mere collection of postures and to whom the joys of youth have become a dim recollection—Peter Pan has an opportunity to tell the financial stringency has had a depressing effect upon your once sunny disposition and you are looking out into the future through smoked glasses—go and listen to Peter Pan's philosophy of life. It is the star of the evening and he has breathed a spirit of optimism into his city tale which has been heard abroad in this glorious west for many years but presented in another form and yet withal in a form that the younger generation can understand in as large a degree as the grown-ups.

It was a great sign of encouragement to those who have at heart the development of Calgary as a centre of dramatic art, to see the magnificent audience which greeted Miss Adams last night on the occasion of her first appearance in the Canadian Northwest. Miss Adams recast her part to play to large and enthusiastic audiences—they greet her everywhere she goes—but it surely must have been apparent to her last night that she was sounding her note of optimism to an audience which in point of numbers and enthusiasm was the very best that Calgary could assemble. Many of them had tender recollections of Lady Beale, Maggie Wylie and Peter Pan in the days gone by but there was a new star of the evening and the talented company an dthe spectacular beauty of the production (and one could include in nothing but the most laudable and yet fall short of a graphic description of the play) but to appreciate "Peter Pan" really is to see it. There is no occasion for repeating the story of the play as it has been repeated at length in the columns of the press, as well as through the medium of circulars. Suffice it to say, however, that the star of the evening and the star of the imagination is in any way necessary to realize that Sir James Barrie wrote the part of "Peter Pan" with Maude Adams in mind. She is the very personification of youthful buoyancy and the charm of manner which she imparts to every action makes it easy to appreciate why she has become the best of all actresses throughout this continent. Rarely has such enthusiasm been aroused in a Calgary audience and in evidence last night and many hopes were expressed that Miss Adams would favor us with an annual visit hereafter.

It was only natural that an actress with the artistic perceptions of Miss Adams should be surrounded by a most capable supporting company and with every detail of stage mechanism and color effect harmonizing to make a finished production. This was the Sherman Grand never displayed stage effects that were a greater delight to the eye than is in evidence in "Peter Pan." The musical numbers interspersed throughout the play and between the acts are also a most enjoyable feature of the performance.

Altogether, "Peter Pan" can be considered the most unique, wholesome, and at the same time the most enjoyable offering we have been offered at the Sherman Grand this season and anybody who fails to take advantage of the three remaining performances will have cause to regret it.
