Postage is extra. Remittances should be made by Postal Note, Post Office or Express Money Order, or Bank Notes at current rates of exchange.

United States bank notes and silver are accepted at face to any amount, and U. S. stamps up to $\$ 1.00$.
Canadian correspondents will find postal notes convenient for small remittances, but where these camot be readily obtained, stamps or silver will be accepted.

Correspondents in British Colonies (except Canada) may remit in stamps to any amount. Hish values and sets ( $1 / 4 \mathrm{p}$ to is) are preferred. Badly ceatred stamps are not wanted.

From correspondents in all other countries $\{$ will accept current unused stamps up to $\$ 2.00$. Stamps must be well centred. High values or sets are prefered.
