auch. PRUNE MERINGUE. — One pound of meded prunes stewed in a pint of wine and hair a pint of water; a pint of new milk witter with the yolks of three eggs. The whites of the same are beaten with two table-spoonfuls of sugar and a few drops of lemon acid to a very stiff froth. Cover the bottom and sides of a deep baking dish with sponge cake. Then put a layer of the prunes, then a layer of white sugar; then take prunes and sugar alternately till the dish is nearly full. Then pour in the milk and yellows and then a layer of cake. Then pile the mer-ingue (of whites, sugar and lemon), making it highest in the centre. Brown slightly in the stove.
