

MULTIPLICATIVE NUMERALS.

Nitukskaowa = Once.	Naoyaowa = Six times.
Natokaowa = Twice.	Īkīćekayaowa = Seven "
Niokskaowa = Three times.	Nanīsoyaowa = Eight "
Nīsoyaowa = Four "	Piksoyaowa = Nine "
Nīsītoyaowa = Five "	Kepoyaowa = Ten "
Kepī nīśīkupūtoyaowa = Eleven times.	
" natsīkupūtoyaowa = Twelve "	
" niokupūtoyaowa = Thirteen "	
" nīsoakupūtoyaowa = Fourteen "	

All the other multiplicative numerals are formed on the same plan by adding *yaowa* to the contracted forms of the cardinal numbers.

Tcanīćo kīśīťūpoqśīststcī akapyoyis = How many times did you go to town? Nīsoyaowa nīśīťūpoqśīstcī = I went four times.

Ordinals.

Petsīstoye = First.	Omoqśīśīťūqp = Fifth
Omoqśīstokūqp = Second.	Omoqtaoqp = Sixth.
Omoqsoqskuqp = Third.	Omoqtokīćekūqp = Seventh.
Omoqśīsoqp = Fourth.	Omoqtanīsoqp = Eighth, etc.

Numerical Combinations.

Aq and Aqk when used in combination with a number mean *perhaps*, as:

Aqkītukskūm = Perhaps there is one.
Aqśīstokūm = Perhaps there are two.
Aqsokskūm = " " three.
Aqśīsoyim = " " four.
Aqśīśīto = " " five.
Aqkao = " " six.
Aqkīćekūm = " " seven.

The other combinations are formed on the same plan.

Name combined with numbers signifies *only*.

Nametukskūm = Only one.	Namao = Only six.
Namestokūm = " two.	Namoqkīćekūm = " seven.
Nameokskūm = " three.	Namanīsoyim = " eight.
Namesoyim = " four.	Namepiqso = " nine.
Namesīto = " five.	Namekepo = " ten.
