The original document was presented to the Provincial Secretary in October, 1919, and many of the recommendations were immediately put into effect. The following commendable progress should be noted—provision for the establishment of a training school for mental defectives on the Essondale property; arrangement for a new building at Essondale for acute cases of mental disease, and for the erection of a nurses' residence at New Westminster; abandonment of the present building used as an Industrial School for Boys; extension of the Special Class system in Vancouver Public Schools, etc., etc.
