

Foreign Policy

While concentrating most of its efforts on achieving national unity, Cameroon maintains an active and prudent foreign policy based on two principles: friendly relations with all countries which respect its sovereignty, and opposition to colonialism and racist regimes. As a non-aligned country, Cameroon has close contacts with both Western and socialist countries. Most of its foreign assistance, however, comes from the Western countries.

On the African scene, Cameroon is a strong supporter of the Organization of African Unity. It is also a member of the Bank of Central African States (BEAC) and the Customs Union of Central African States (UDEAC).
