

ARTICLE XII

The Government of Ghana shall inform Canadian firms and Canadian personnel of the local laws and regulations which may concern them in the performance of their duties.

ARTICLE XIII

Any differences which may arise relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of this Agreement or of any subsidiary arrangement or loan agreement shall be settled by means of negotiations between the Government of Canada and the Government of Ghana or in any other manner mutually agreed upon by them.

ARTICLE XIV

This Agreement which supersedes the December 1963 General Agreement shall enter into force on signature and shall remain in force until terminated by either party on six (6) months' notice in writing to the other party. The responsibilities of the Government of Canada and the Government of Ghana with regard to projects being carried out by virtue of subsidiary arrangements of loan agreements entered into pursuant to Article II of this Agreement and begun prior to the receipt of the termination notice referred to above shall continue until completion of such projects as if the present Agreement remained in force in respect of and for the whole duration of each such project.
