Arrivals:

- The arrival of Heads of Delegation, Foreign Ministers and Finance Ministers at formal Hospitality/Summit Events is governed by the reverse order of precedence.
- 2. The Canadian Government Representatives should, in principle, be the first to arrive at all sites to fulfill their role as Hosts.
- 3. For example:

Arriving first: Canada

Arriving second: The Commission of the European

Communities

Arriving third: Italy Arriving fourth: Japan

Arriving fifth: Federal Republic of Germany

Arriving sixth: United Kingdom

Arriving seventh: France

Arriving last: United States of America

Departures:

- 1. The Departure of Heads of Delegation, Foreign Ministers and Finance Ministers from formal Hospitality/Summit Events is decided by the regular order of precedence.
- 2. The Canadian Government Representatives should, in principle, be the last to depart to fulfill their role as Hosts.
- 3. For example:

Departing first: United States of America

Departing second: France

Departing third: United Kingdom

Departing fourth: Federal Republic of Germany

Departing fifth: Japan Departing sixth: Italy
