- Activities include:

- personnel administration functions commonly found in domestic departments;
- functions unique to rotational foreign service personnel, for example, recruitment, assignment, promotion, relocation and administration of a range of services provided under the Foreign Service Directives.

2.6 CENTRAL STAFF UNITS

Director General Policy Planning

Mr. Howard Balloch

- provides advice on the overall direction of Canadian foreign policy based on analyses of a wide range of trade, economic and political issues;
- coordinates Canada's contribution to the political issues at G-7 economic summits;
- assists in preparing Canada's contribution to the political agendas of Commonwealth and la Francophonie summit meetings; and
- prepares speeches by ministers and senior departmental officials on broad policy themes.

Chief of Protocol

Ms. Pierrette Lucas

- provides services and protection to foreign missions in or accredited to Canada in accordance with Canada's international obligations under the <u>Vienna Conventions</u> on <u>Diplomatic and Consular Relations</u> and Canada's domestic obligations under the <u>Diplomatic and Consular Privileges and Immunities Act</u>;
- plans and organizes official visits to Canada by foreign Heads of State, Heads of Government, Ministers of Foreign Affairs and International Trade;
- supports visits abroad by the Governor General and departmental ministers; and
- administers the Hospitality Centre and the Government Guest House.

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
