

meet annually in Canada or the USSR in turn to reach final agreement on accommodation of participants 4 months after the lists are submitted. The dates of meeting will be agreed upon through diplomatic channels. The receiving side meets the visiting delegation in the host country at its own expense.

2. The sides will encourage agreements on direct exchanges between universities and other institutions of higher education. Persons exchanged will improve their competence, conduct research, deliver lectures and participate in seminars. These exchanges will be undertaken in addition to the exchange programmes under sections 1A, 1B mentioned above. They will be the subject of additional direct agreements between interested universities and institutes and the conditions of exchanges under this programme may not be compulsory for them.

3. The Soviet side agrees to receive annually 12 Canadian students, at the expense of the Canadian side for a term of up to 4 months (from February to May) to study the Russian language at the Moscow Pushkin Institute of the Russian Language.
