## BUSINESS OF SUPPLY

ALLOTTED DAY S.O. 58—NON-CONFIDENCE MOTION—CALL FOR  
WITHDRAWAL OF BUDGET

**Right Hon. Joe Clark (Leader of the Opposition)** moved:

That in the opinion of this House the opposition of Canadians from all walks of life, as expressed to the Members of Parliament of all three parties, proves conclusively that the budget of November 12, as amended by the statement in this House by the Minister of Finance on December 18, should be withdrawn and immediately replaced by a new budget.

**He said:** Madam Speaker, the purpose of this motion is straightforward and simple. It asks that the government withdraw a budget which was a mistake and that it bring in a new budget to create jobs for the Canadian people and, if not to create confidence, at least to bring a halt to the despair that is stalking the country.
