By Mr. Pugsley: Negatived (Yeas 21; Nays 36), 1080.

For want of a quorum, 651. During pleasure, 175. Ascension Day, 376. On account of War Conference in London, Eng., 175. Victoria Day, 413. Dominion Day, 613.

Adjournments under Rule 39:

By Mr. Pardee:—"The proper treatment, care, etc., of returned soldiers, and the appointment of a committee to sit during the adjournment to consider same." Negatived, 152.

By Mr. Lemieux:—"The evils alleged to exist among our soldiers overseas arising out of the liquor traffic in camps and military centres." Withdrawn, 242.

By Mr. Kyte:—"The price of flour in Canada, and the necessity of taking action to prevent further undue advance in." Negatived, 302.

By Mr. Devlin:—"That the use of grains for brewing and distilling purposes should be discontinued." Withdrawn, 328.

By Mr. Macdonald:—"The menace to National interests by the German submarine campaign, and what Canada should do to deal with the situation." Withdrawn, 362.

By Mr. Oliver:—"The lifting of the rails on the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway west of Edmonton now in progress." Negatived, 449.

By Mr. Turriff:—"Farm labour question in Western Canada." Withdrawn, 760.

By Mr. Macdonald:—"The necessity of supplying munitions to Great Britain during the continuation of the war, etc.," 1077. Motion (Mr. Hazen) to proceed to Orders of the Day, agreed to (Yeas 35; Nays 20), 1078.
