MOTION

For Friday, 15th September, 1950

By the Honourable Senator Robertson:—

14th September,—That when this House adjourns on completion of current business of the session it stand adjourned until February 14, 1951, provided always that if it appears to the satisfaction of the Honourable the Speaker, after consultation with His Majesty's government, that the public interest requires that the House should meet at an earlier time during the adjournment, the Honourable the Speaker may give notice that he is so satisfied, and thereupon the House shall meet at the time stated in such notice, and shall transact its business as if it had been duly adjourned to that time.
