Extract from Report of Dr. Walter: -

"While the individual members are well qualified to do graduate work, The Department as a whole is handicapped in a variety of ways. German, although of obvious utility and, in many cases, necessity to university students, is not taught in our High Schools, and is moreover excluded from the list of subjects prescribed by the Education Council for the Teachers' Certificates.

As long as such very unwise regulations are in force we cannot expect a supply of Honour undergraduates, mlet alone Graduate students, from our own Province.In the few cases in which students from outside applied for admission to the Graduate School their application had to be turned down."
