Sept. 23. M. de Luckner beat a detachment of the French cavalry near Norten, and took prifoners one Lieutenant Colonel, feveral fubalterns, and 107 dragoons.

Sept. — Colonel Belling furpriz'd a body of 2000 Swedes in the neighbourhood of Prentzlow, and made 2 officers, 6 fubalterns, and 250 private men, prifoners of war.

Sept. — The Temple and Griffin, part of the fquadron under the orders of Sir James Douglafs, cut out feven veffels from the Grenades, (amongft which was his Majefty's floop Virgin, taken, in April laft, by the French) after filencing the batteries which defended them; these thips, in their passage from the Grenades to Antigua, fell in with and took thirteen other veffels laden with provifions for Martinico.

Sept. 27. Torgau furrender'd to the army of the Empire under the command of the Prince de Deux Ponts, and the Pruffian garrifon of 2400 men were made prifoners of war.

October 2. The army of the Empire, gain'd a confiderable advantage over the corps of Pruffians, commanded by General Hulfen, near Wittenberg.

Ollober 3. General Werner attack'd the Swedish corps under General Ehrenschwerdt, at or near Pafewalch, made 16 officers and 500 private men prisoners, and took 6 pieces of cannon.
