

CHAPTER X.

OF UNIVERSITY REPORTS, PUBLICATIONS, AND LECTURES.

1. The Vice-Chancellor shall each year prepare and publish the Annual Calendar of the University, in such manner, as to expense and mode of publication, as may be determined by the Board of Governors; and it shall be the duty of the Officers of the Corporation, of the several Faculties, or affiliated colleges and of affiliated schools, to furnish all necessary returns and information for the preparation of this and other publications or reports of the University.
2. The annual report of the University to the Visitor shall be prepared by the Vice-Chancellor, and submitted to the Corporation at the regular meeting in October. It shall cover the Academic instead of the Calendar year.
3. On the Founder's birthday (October 6th), in each year (unless this date should happen to fall on a Saturday or a Sunday), a lecture or address on some subject connected with the general interests of the University shall be delivered before the Convocation and students, by the Vice-Chancellor, or, in his absence or with his consent, by the Vice-Principal, or by such other person as may be appointed by the Corporation; such lecture or address to be designated the Annual University Lecture or Address.
4. It shall be competent for the Corporation at any regular meeting to make arrangements for the delivery of special courses of lectures or of addresses by eminent persons for the benefit of members of the University or of any particular Faculty, with the consent or concurrence of such Faculty.
5. It shall be competent for the Vice-Chancellor, on recommendation of any Faculty, to authorize the delivery of any address or lecture to its students on any subject or subjects connected with the course of such Faculty by any eminent person not a member of the staff of the University.
6. No expense shall be incurred in connection with any lectures or addresses except by vote of the Board of Governors.
