FIVE VICTORIA CROSS HEROES

His Majesty the King has been graciously pleased to award the Victoria Cross to the following officer, non-commissioned officers, and men.

2nd Lieut. Toby Starr, 8th (Service) Bn. R. Southshire Regt.

For most conspicuous bravery. When the enemy exploded a mine, Lieutenant Starr and many men of two platoons were blown into the air. But, though much shaken, he at once organized a party with a machine gun to mow down the oncoming enemy, and having effectively repulsed them and stopped the advance, he was instrumental in rescuing, although under fire, a number of his own buried men and bringing them into safety, carrying several unaided in his arms.

Through all this perilous work Lieutenant Starr remained unhurt.
