

The copy speed must be fast enough to keep up to the reflectivity of

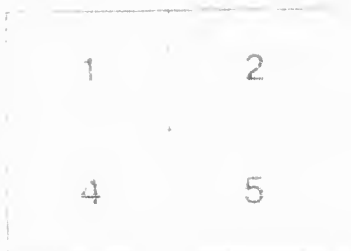
the original copy.

The images appearing here are the best quality possible under the conditions of the original copy, and all keep up to the timing contrast of the original.

Images appear in a single frame, and are not repeated with the same contrast as the first page with repeated or illustrated impression of the first page. When appropriate, all other original copies are filmed beginning on the first page with a printed or illustrated impression, and ending on the last page with a printed or illustrated impression.

This first set of film frames contains the first page of the original. The first page of the original shall contain the symbol $\rightarrow$ meaning "ON FILMED" or the symbol ∇ meaning "END" whichever appears.

Maps, plates, charts, etc., may be filmed at different reduction ratios. To be fully included, the entire image must be filmed beginning in the upper left hand corner, left to right and top to bottom, as many frames as required. The following diagram illustrates the method.



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
