current expenses of the Association,) without first having received a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting therefor.

ARTICLE VIII.

QUORUM.

Twelve members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

ARTICLE IX.

IRRELEVANT SUBJECTS.

No subject foreign to the purposes of this Association shall be introduced at any of its meetings. No political or religious discussions shall be tolerated. Any member transgressing this Article shall be liable to expulsion.

ARTICLE X.

DUPATION OF ORGANIZATION.

This Association shall continue its organization as long as twelve members are willing to sustain it. Should the members at any one time be reduced to less than that number, they can, if so disposed, dissolve it, and divide the property as they may see fit.

ARTICLE XI.

BY-LAWS.

This Associ tion shall have power to make such By-Laws and Rules of Order as shall not contravene this Constitution.
