**New World's Record
For Ski Long Jump**

Steamboat Springs, Col., Feb. 28.—The world's record ski jump of 205 feet was equaled today by Anders Haugen of St. Paul at the annual ski tournament. He won the professional event with 319 points, defeating by six points his brother, Lars Haugen, who failed to retain

his footing after jumps of 209 and 212 feet. Nels Jensen of the Great Lake Naval Training Station won the amateur event with 265 points and a jump of 198 feet.
