WHAT WOULD GENTLEMAN DO NAT GOODWIN GIVES REPLY

Brand New Comedy Placed on
Boards at the Princess and
Pleases Large Audiences.

Last night Mr. Goodwin produced for the first time on this continent a play in three acts, by Gilbert Doyle, "What Would a Gentleman Do?" has an old world and an old-time flavor, and may fairly be described as part comedy, part melodrama. As a drama it is weak, but is redeemed by a certain deftness of characterization, of which Mr. Goodwin and his company made the most. While it was not enthusiastically received, it was favorably received by a large audience, whose tribute was paid more to the excellence of the acted than to the merits of the written drama.

The motive of the play is by no means new. The rich parvenu, with social ambitions, in the externals of one—has been utilized before with greater and more convincing adroitness. It is in a measure unfortunate that the author, who maintains in the first and third acts the comedy standard, drops in the second into pure melodrama. This disturbs the artistic completeness of the play, and clothes it with an atmosphere of unreality which the latest return restoration to more normal lines fails to remove.

In brief, the play deals with various episodes in the life of Dickie Hook, who, from the occupation of a jockey, has risen to the ownership of \$200,000. He has society aspirations, and for their attainment depends on the acquired privilege of posing as the friend and guest of Sir Bruce Kederby, and on the advice of a pocket guide to elude the society standard. This disturbs the artistic completeness of the play, and clothes it with an atmosphere of unreality which the latest return restoration to more normal lines fails to remove.
