A DAY OF JUDGMENTS. Court of Appeal Clears the Slate Before Adjudging in the Function—Some of the Decisions.

The most interesting decision given in the Court of Appeal yesterday was that in the famous Johnston case, which is set out in another column, but some of the other 20 cases disposed of are also worthy of mention.

The Court sustained the trial judge's decision in the St. George Engineering Company's suit against T. Eaton & Co. to recover \$5000 damages because the defendants rejected 500 wheels shipped to them.

Mrs. Mary Hill's appeal against the judgment of the Divisional Court, which decided against her in her suit against W. D. Wilson and William Wilson, was dismissed.

The Toronto General Trusts Corporation are defendants in a suit brought by Richard Lynch to set aside an agreement concerning the property of the late William Lynch, a hotelkeeper, King-street west. The estate is valued at \$150,000 and the plaintiff objects to the conveyance of a certain portion of the property to his brother's widow.
