New York, June 23.—Bank clearings at the principal United States cities for the week ended June 23 show total clearances \$1,613,215,955, an increase of 40.2 per cent. as compared with the corresponding week last year. Outside of New York City the clearances were \$610,151,213, increase 20.2 per cent.

For the Dominion of Canada the clearances were as follows: Montreal, \$15,429,473, increase 11.1 per cent.; Toronto, \$10,035,310, increase 21.2 per cent.; Winnipeg, \$1,805,840, increase 11.6 per cent.; Halifax, \$1,151,740, increase 10.8 per cent.; Hamilton, \$685,400, increase 16.2 per cent.; Vancouver, \$708,857; Victoria, \$466,218.
