Stock Brokers Fail.

LONDON, March 14.—The failure of H. M. Lindsay & Co., stock brokers, is an event of 24 hours' duration. The firm, which was established in 1854, had a capital of £100,000. It was one of the largest and most successful firms in the City. The failure was caused by a shortage of funds. The firm had borrowed heavily from the Bank of England, and when the bank refused to lend more, the firm was forced to close.

LONDON, March 14.—A dispatch to the Times from Madrid describes the Spanish condition being such that the foreign paper is quoted as an earnest of an impending alliance.
