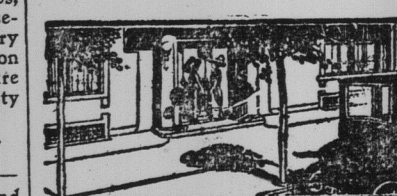

SANTA CLAUS' PRACTICAL.

War Conditions to Change Character of
Gifts Made by New York Police.

Santa Claus, in the blue uniform of a
policeman, is going to be a little more
utilitarian in his gifts this year. No
candy, because sugar is scarce; prefer-
ably no toys, for clothing and food are
necessities and toys must, rather regret-
fully, be described as luxuries. These
are the recommendations made by Po-
lice Commissioner Woods to those who
would contribute to the second Christ-
mas given by and through the police to
thousands of poor children who would
not otherwise be reached. This year,
as last year, trees will be set up in every
police station, and part of the duties of
the men on the beats will be to find out
the children who have been forgotten
by Santa Claus in his other incarnations.
Meanwhile, Commissioner Woods has
written a letter for the guidance of per-
sons who want to contribute to help
this Christmas celebration, in which he
says: "Last year we arranged to give each
child, as nearly as possible, an article of
clothing, a toy, some fruit, and candy.
This year, while we plan to make the
occasion as festive in spirit as before,
I feel that the character of the gifts
should be somewhat changed. We have
all been asked to save sugar, and many
of us have given up having candy in our
homes. Probably toys had better not be
given this year, either; for we should
try to make every dollar contributed go
to supply a necessity. Clothes and food
are necessities, and we plan to include
these in the gifts, so far as possible.
The Christmas party will thus mean
just as much to the small people and
will be a material help to their parents.
