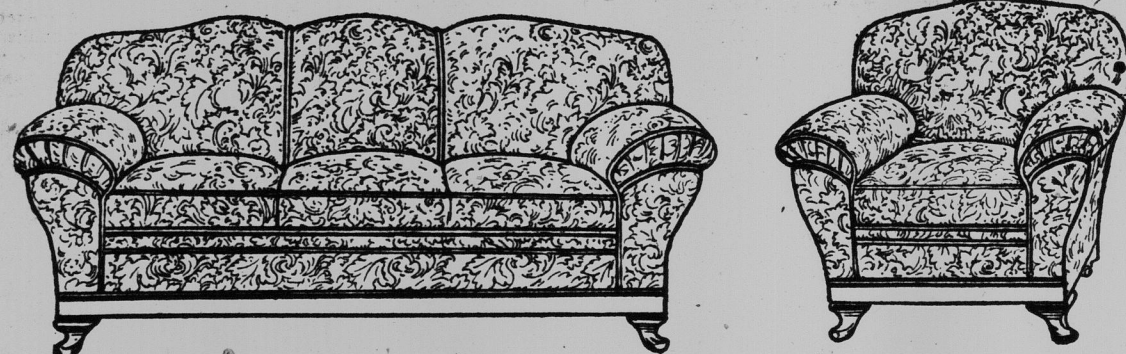

Boston, April 19.—"The best reason for being glad that I'm back in America is—bath tubs," says Mrs. Martin Johnson, wife of the explorer, who is visiting here after an adventurous journey with her husband into African wilds.

"What bathing I did was more often that not in an 'elephant pool' with a native woman acting as maid, and plenty of curious—very curious—native men poking their heads through the fringes of my jungle grass screen. Here's a picture my husband took during one of the bathing operations. I didn't

feel as happy about it as I looked when he snapped the camera." The handsome wife of the explorer had many thrilling adventures. On several occasions her gun had extricated her husband from perilous situations. Among other trophies, she brought down a rhinoceros with her rifle. The main object of Mr. Johnson was to get motion pictures of wild animals. Living scores of native "hunters" succeeded in having many curious and interesting beasts driven into the range of his machine. Considerable hardship was encountered, but the results achieved were worth it according to both Mr. and Mrs. Johnson.

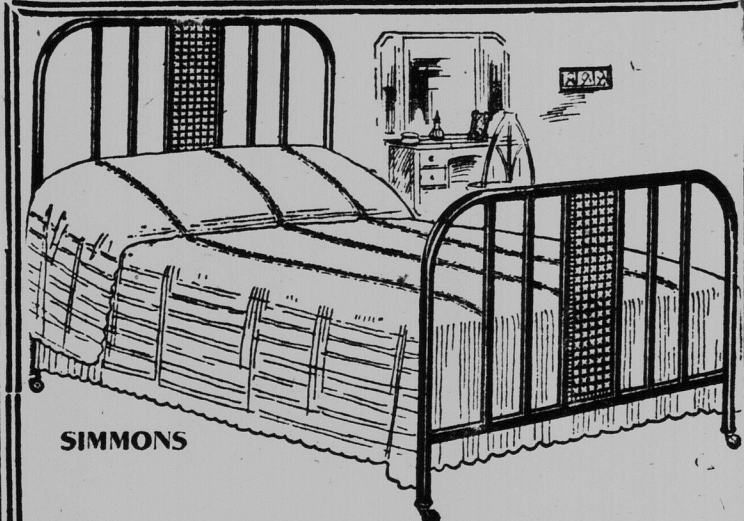

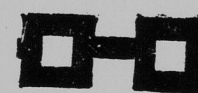
