DOCTOR SILENT AS TO HIS CURE; PATIENTS TALK

All Are Sure New Cancer Treatment Has Benefited Them.

Toronto, July 15.—Doctors at St. Michael's Hospital are extremely reticent about expressing an opinion on Dr. Glover's cancer serum; in fact they positively refuse at present to say a word on the subject, preferring to wait until a definite opinion can be expressed. 
