THE PROGRAMME FOR ORCHARD FIELD DAY

Object is to Help Apple Growers and Encourage Industry—Conducted Under Government Auspices.

An orchard field day is being held on Aug. 28 under the auspices of the Department of Agriculture, Fruit Growers' Association, Fredericton Board of Trade and Dominion Experimental Station.

The objects of the trip are two-fold: first, to give apple growers an opportunity to observe methods of culture used and results obtained in other orchards.

The second object is, through the inclusion in the party of prominent business men, immigration officials and representatives of boards of trade and the press, to give a better understanding of the aims and ambitions of the fruit growers and the difficulties they encounter, as well as to secure more and better publicity for the splendid opportunities for commercial apple growing which New Brunswick affords.
