PRINCE APPOINTED DEPUTY MINISTER

Has Been Acting in Office—
Webb Named Chief Forester.

FREDERICTON, April 26. — The following appointments in the provincial civil service have been announced:

G. H. Prince, who has been Acting Deputy Minister of Lands and Mines for the last year, has been appointed Deputy Minister, the appointment dating from April 18.

Leland S. Webb, who has been acting chief forester, has been confirmed in that position, an order-in-council appointing him as chief forester.

Mr. Prince is a native of Hammond River, Kings county. In 1908 he entered the University of New Brunswick and was one of the first four-year students to graduate from that institution in forestry in 1912.
