**TERRIERS CORNER PANTHER.**

Washington, July 7.—The killing of the famous old White River mountain lion, one of the largest ever known in Arizona, has brought to the archives of the Biological Survey a story of a feat as thrilling as any filmed in the movies. The animal had been particularly destructive to live stock in the vicinity of White River crossing. There the lion tried to whip the little terriers, trilled the animal to the cliffs near White River crossing. The terriers would not yield and the animal took to a cave in the side of the cliff.

Repeated charging failed to frighten the terriers, and the lion backed into the den. Miller, lowered over the side of the cliff and dangling from the end of a rope in front of the den, shot the lion, secured the prey and was pulled safely to the top of the cliff.

**Only Six Buildings Standing In Town**

Goldfield, a Boom Place in Nevada, Wiped Out by Fire.

Tonopah, Nev., July 7.—The town of Goldfield, with the exception of six buildings was burned to the ground yesterday. One man is dead from causes attributed to the fire, a woman is missing and is believed to have perished and several persons were treated for burns as a result of the conflagration now believed to have been of incendiary origin, started as part of a bootlegger's feud. Damage was estimated at \$500,000.

Fire Chief I. N. Galliac of Goldfield, declared that he believed an enemy of a bootlegger started the blaze in a building in the rear of the Brown-Pharmer garage.

Van D. MacArthur, after carrying furniture from his home, died from heart failure.

Residents were returning last night from the mountainside, where they fed with their belongings. Food has reached there from Tonopah. All of the local supplies has been destroyed. Miners' shacks on the outskirts of the town are being rehabilitated under the direction of a relief committee.

The main buildings surviving the fire are the hospital, railroad station, old John Scott's bank building, Goldfield Hotel, post office and Elks' Club. Goldfield a "boom gold mining camp" was established in 1904.

In the police court yesterday afternoon there was a further hearing in the case against Allen E. Beyer charged with four violations of the new pass laws.
