In presenting the Treasurer's Annual Report for 1899, it may be well to add a word of explanation for the information of the members and adherents of our church. As the finances of the church are dependent on the voluntary contributions of the congregation, this explanation will no doubt be duly appreciated.

The three sources of income are envelope subscriptions, pew rents, and open collections. A portion of the envelopes is applied to the payment of the pastor's salary and the parsonage rent; the balance, together with the pew rents and open collections, is applied to the payment of the other current expenses and the interest on the mortgage.
