ATHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for the better Preamble. establishment and maintenance of Common Schools in the several Villages, Towns, Cities, Townships and Counties of Upper 4 Canada: Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the Act Act 12 Vic. 6 passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, An Act for the better establishment and maintenance of Public

8 Schools in Upper Canada, and for repealing the present School Act, shall be and is hereby repealed: Provided always, that all All School

10 school sections or other school divisions, together with all elections and appointments to office, all agreements, contracts, assessments and appointments, 12 rate-bills, made under the authority of said Act, or of any preceding

Act, and not annulled by the said Act, shall be valid and in full force 14 and binding upon all parties concerned, as if made under the authority of this Act, and until altered, modified or superseded according to the

16 provisions of the same.

I. Election and Duties of School Trustees.

II. And be it enacted, That the annual meetings for the elections 18 School Trustees, as hereinafter provided by this Act, shall be held in all the Villages, Towns, Cities and Townships of Upper 20 Canada, on the second Tuesday in January in each year, commencing at the hour of Ten of the clock in the forenoon.

III. And be it enacted, That in all school divisions (except in Cities, Towns and incorporated Villages,) which have been esta-24 blished according to law, and which have been called "School sections," and in which there shall be three Trustees in office at the

divisions, elections, contracts, &c., confirmed.

Annual School meetings to be held throughout U. C. on the second Tuesday in January, at 10 o'clock A. M.

One Trustee in each School section to be elected at each annual School meeting.
