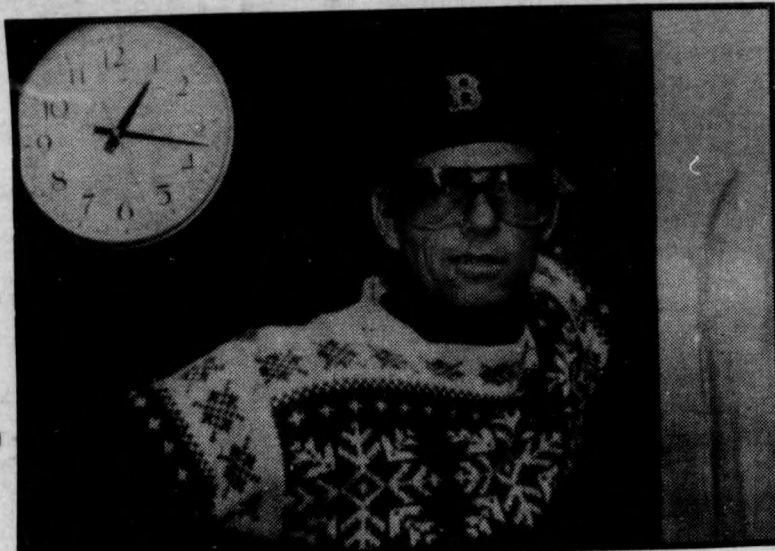

The game was played under adverse field conditions at Buchannon Field; bad weather had made it impossible to play the final at College Field. Although Buchannon Field was in slightly better shape, the mixture of ice and snow through the center of the field made ball control difficult resulting in a very physical style of soccer being played.

A.P. went ahead in the game by 1 as a result of a hard shot by Duane MacAfee deflecting off of a Dozer defender. Peter MacKinnon then brought the A.P. team up to two, and in doing so scoring the winning goal, from a 40 yd. free kick. This was the first of MacKinnon's two goal performance. Capping off the A.P. Team's win was Billy Dunnitt with the fourth goal for the victors.

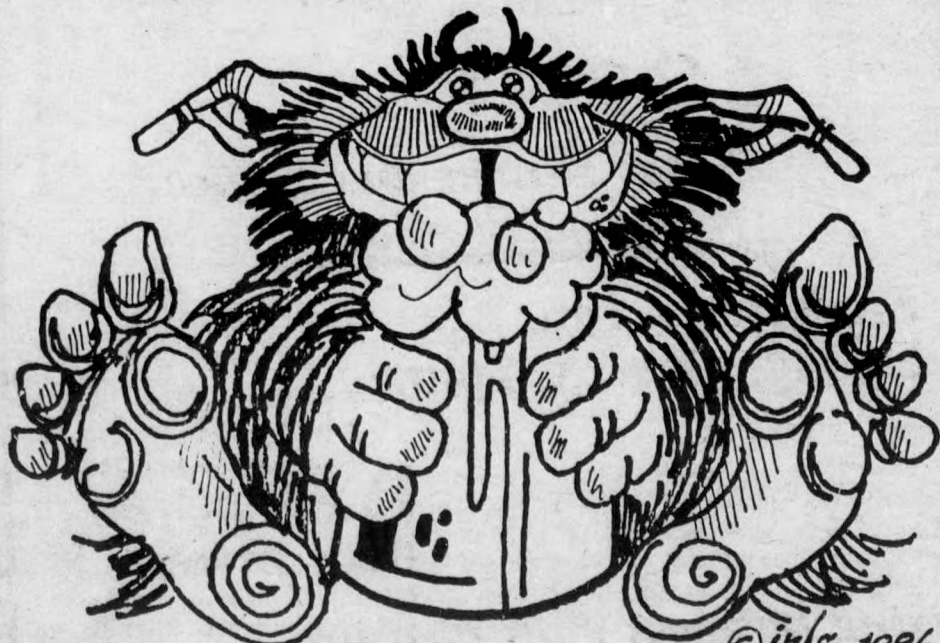
