Seats to view Procession -

Government of United Kingdom erecting a number of stands
along route -

Portion of these seats will be available for persons
from Dominions;

Canadian Government erecting stand in front of Canada House -

Reservations for these, as announced in press, were
to be made to High Commissioner in London;

Probable cost £5 to £4 per seat;

Private citizens controlling points of vantage, also making
arrangements;

Steamship and Hotel Accommodation -

Reservations have been made for official guests of
Canadian Government;

Empire Parliamentary Association has made necessary
reservations for their Canadian guests
invited;

Estimates - House will be asked to provide necessary monies to
cover expenses.
