With Cheque.

Sir,

I beg to enclose herewith cheque No 914 for \$107.45 in full settlement of your account dated the 1st October, and rendered at \$111.80 for desks supplied for the Restigouche Indian school.

The reason for the reduction is that the Agent has reported that he found it necessary to engage a carpenter, to whom he paid \$3.75 to put the desks together, they having arrived in separate parts. I may also remark that Mr Pitre states he paid \$2.00 cartage on the desks from Campbellton Station, and \$1.00 for ferrage ferrage, which last mentioned amounts have not been charged against your account.
