
Sir:-

In reply to your letter of the 29th ultimo enclosing draft for \$400.00 to be applied to the purchase of the S.1/2, and N.E.1/4, Sec. 25, Tp. 20, Rge. 17, W-2-M. I am pleased to say that the same has been divided as follows, \$336.50 Principal and \$63.50 Interest, the interest being computed to the date of payment, the 29th ultimo and applied as \$19.45 on the S.W.1/4, \$15.15 to the S.E.1/4, and \$28.90 to the N.E.1/4.
