Description of Railway Line through the Spellam
Indian Reserve*

All triangular the land occupied by the above railway
running through the Spellam Indian Reserve.

Beginning at a point on the North Boundary of the Spellam
Indian Reserve 1466 feet West East of the point situated at the corner of lot 150
G.I. Okanagan Div. Yale Dist. Thence S. Easterly on a curve of $7^{\circ}30'$ a distance
of 289 1/2 feet bend of curve. Thence on a tangent approx $S 41^{\circ}15' E$ a distance of
3546 1/10 feet. Thence on a curve of $4^{\circ}5'$ Eastward a distance of 1000 feet.

Thence on a tangent $S 1^{\circ}35' E$ approx. a distance of 3693 7/10 feet. Thence
on a 5° curve to the South Westward a distance of 520 feet. Thence on
a tangent approx $S 24^{\circ}30' W$ a distance of 527 1/10 feet. Thence on a 7° curve
Southernly to a point on the South Boundary of the Res. a distance of
511 feet to a point 344 1/10 feet westerly from the point at the N.E. corner
of the aforesaid Reserve. Giving a width of 50 feet each side of the
Centre line of said Railway. Containing by admeasurement
23.16 acres, as shown by plan of record in Dept of Ind.
