

(c) Engr Development

- (i) Results of fast water trials at Yuma, Arizona showed that the floating Bailey Br with open deck pontoons is not as satisfactory as the closed deck type.
- (ii) A moving picture, illustrating characteristics of Petrol Gels for use with the Ronson Lighter, has been made by the Directorate.
- (iii) CMBQ requested that all Inglis Bridge eqpt, Cdn pattern for Overseas be stored and further manufacture be discontinued.
- (iv) Tests of Raffia for camouflage showed that it made an excellent garnishing material except that it has poor fire retardent qualities after weathering.
- (v) Approval has been given for the constr of a second Cdn Universal Testle to meet Class 70 loads and 35 foot specifications.
