3., and of vital importance, is the furnishing of supplies of all kinds to the British and Allied Powers - munitions, manufactures and raw materials and food stuffs.

The urgent necessity of a constant supply of munitions, and the ability of Canada, because of its industrial equipment and its relative accessibility to the main theatres of the war, to meet these needs in great measure are apparent. It is a subject on which there has been consultation with the Government of the United Kingdom.
