QUESTIONED BY THE DEFENDING OFFR

- A. No sir. When the veh was signed over Sgt. Walker just tossed over the book and I signed for it.
- Q. You know you are responsible for the veh when you signed for it?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Had it ever happened that you let your veh be driven by someone else before letting Sgt. Walker know?
- A. I never gave anyone else permission before. The Sgt. just let someone else drive my veh.
- Q. Did you think you could let someone else?
- A. Yes definitely. The truck is signed to me and I am responsible for it.
- Q. When you started out in the morning what time was it?
- A. I don't know.
- Q. What time after breakfast?
- A. Between 9 and 10.
- Q. Where did you have dinner?
- A. I didn't hame any.
- Q. You got back to camp at what time?
- A. 3:30.
