I WAS born in the Church of Rome in 1809, and I was ordained priest in the year 1833. For twenty-five years I was a priest of that Church, and I tell you frankly that I loved the Church of Rome, and she loved me. I never missed an opportunity of speaking to a Protestant in Canada in order to prove to him that his Church was not the Church of Christ, and my zeal and success was so great that, during my ministry, I persuaded ninety-three Protestant families to become Roman Catholics. But, thanks be to God, after my conversion, I went back to those very same people with the saving light of the Gospel in my hand, and, with the exception of three, they have all come back to the side of Jesus, where they have found peace.
