PITT'S HORSE POWER.

It is now universally admitted that Pitt's Horse Power, when properly constructed, and of good material, is the best Power in use where eight or ten horse power is required. It requires, however, considerable knowledge of them to be able to construct them properly; and the only reason why they have failed, in my case, to give satisfaction, is a deficiency of such knowledge in the manufacturer. I have made these Powers for a great number of years, and am free to admit that it was only by costly experience
